A commuter who joins a vanpool as a **new*** rider will receive a one time rebate of \$100, after riding in a vanpool for three months. The rider is entitled to claim the rebate after the last day of the third month of ridership.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ◆ Vanpool must be registered with Traffic Solutions and commuter leased or owned (not employer owned.)
- ◆ Vanpool must begin or end in Santa Barbara County.
- ◆ The participant must ride the vanpool for three consecutive months and must be *new to vanpool commuting.
- ◆ Complete and return the attached application to Traffic Solutions.
